

ACRE General Membership Meeting

December 19, 2018

Call to Order: a quorum was present, and the meeting was called to order at 10:04 am by Mike Lee, President.

Opening Prayer/Pledge: The opening prayer was given by Richard McBryde followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Legal Advisor: Clyde Keenan reported to the membership there is not enough information out yet to answer questions on the possible pension fund intrusion. He told members he would be staying on top of all discussions and working for the members good.

Pension Oversight Committee: Bobby Collins reported a total of \$2,240,918,109.00 currently in the pension fund and it was 85.531% funded which is down from last month.

Membership: Darryl White thanked all the members for keeping their dues up to date.

Benevolence: George Harris wished all members a Merry Christmas.

Insurance Oversight Committee: Francis Bradley wished all members good health, Merry Christmas, and a Happy New Year.

President: Mike Lee reported audits going on in the City of Memphis benefits and some mistakes have been found. He stressed the importance to check on your beneficiary listed with the City, FOP, MPA, MFFA as there have been errors found. He discussed the \$300 payment required by going to the ER in care or by Ambulance if you had the City insurance. He wished all the members a Merry Christmas.

Without further questions or business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:45 to attend the Christmas luncheon provided by the City of Memphis Credit Union. Richard McBryde prayed for the food we were about to receive, and we were dismissed to the luncheon.
